Our base, the 18th Century, family run, Lion Hotel \*\*\*, famous for its welcoming atmosphere and caring staff, is located in the heart of the charming, Victorian resort of Criccieth. All rooms are en-suite with TV, hospitality tray and hairdryer. Some rooms are located in the "Castle View Cottage" annex, these rooms are not suitable for anyone with walking difficulties. However the main building does have a lift. Evening entertainment is provided.

## Package itinerary

**FRIDAY** We have an early morning departure for our journey to Wales with suitable refreshment stops route arriving in time to relax before evening meal.

**SATURDAY** Full Day scenic drive through the magnificent Snowdonia National Park taking in ancient oak woodlands, soaring mountains, winding rivers and majestic castles. Calling in at the traditional seaside town of Barmouth where you will find a long golden sandy beach and picturesque harbour, bordered by the dramatically beautiful Mawddach estuary.

**SUNDAY** Travel to Porthmadog for a memorable trip on The Ffestiniog and Welsh Highland Railway. Journey from Porthmadog through the glorious countryside to Caernarfon, allowing you to experience the outstanding scenery from a different perspective in a comfortable railway carriage pulled by an historic steam engine. (see note below) We then rejoin the coach and travel on to Llanfairpwllgwyngyll Woolen Mill, a unique shopping experience where you will find something for everyone, maybe even some early Christmas presents.

**MONDAY** Boarding the coach after breakfast we make our way homewards calling in at Llangollen, a small ancient Welsh town, steeped in myth and legend, situated on the River Dee at the edge of the Berwyn Mountains.
