The Salutation Hotel (AA\*\*\*) is one of the oldest hotels in Scotland located in the heart of Perth City Centre, with one of its most famous guests being Bonnie Prince Charlie. Perth is steeped in history and was formerly the Scottish Capital and a royal residence sitting aside the Silver River Tay. Famous worldwide for its Salmon fishing and its water is an essential ingredient for the locally produced fine Whiskeys. There is a lift to all floors and all bedrooms are en-suite with TV and tea/coffee making facilities and there will be 3 nights evening entertainment.

## Package itinerary

**GOOD FRIDAY 19TH APRIL** Picking up at local points we make our way to the hotel with suitable stops en-route, arriving in time to relax before the evening meal.

**SATURDAY** Full day visit to the small historic seaside University city of Dundee where the River Tay flows into the North Sea with its famous Tay rail and road bridges, which is home to Royal Research Ship Discovery, the ship built in Dundee specifically for Captain Scott's heroic voyage to Antarctica. Dundee is the first city outside of London to get its own V&A design Museum which is recently opened on the refurbished elegant waterfront.

**SUNDAY** Full day tour calling at the Victorian Town of Pitlochry, famous for its Salmon Ladder which has a new visitor centre, and array of shops and local produced goods. Followed by a scenic ride to Blairgowrie poised on the edge of the glens with its breathtaking scenery and well-preserved palaces and castles, where stories of Scotland's turbulent past are a legion.

**MONDAY** A free day to enjoy the historic city of Perth with two public parks, with elegant Georgian town houses, cobbled streets and medieval spires hark back to the towns long and prosperous past, a stylish shopping center with independent boutiques alongside the High Street favorites. Or you may prefer to visit Scone Palace which is situated just a few miles out of the town center via a local bus once the crowning place of the kings of Scotland. (It is not Bank Holiday in Scotland).

**TUESDAY** Boarding the coach after breakfast we make the return journey back to Lincolnshire with suitable comfort stops en-route.
