The hotel does not have any bedrooms with walk in shower's, but it does have ground floor rooms available ,there is a lift to all floors with two nights evening entertainment. The Lakeside Restaurant enjoys stunning views over the hotels gardens adjacent to the lake.

FRIDAY Picking up at local points we make our way to the hotel with suitable stops en-route, you will be served tea/coffee and biscuits on arrival while the porters take your luggage to the bedrooms giving you time to relax before your evening meal.

FULL DAY Travel to Shrewsbury by coach, a pretty town with numerous black and white Tudor style buildings, cobbled streets and Castle and was the first home of Charles Darwin. Enjoy a relaxing 45minute cruise aboard Sabrina, Shrewsbury's passenger boat, sailing around the picturesque River Severn Loop from Victoria Quay including an entertaining commentary, tea/coffee & biscuits, returning back to the hotel by coach.

FULL DAY A morning coach journey to the market town of Bridgnorth for a return scenic journey on the Severn Valley Railway, meandering through the Shropshire countryside to Kidderminster. Re- joining the coach stopping off at the famous Ironbridge Gorge giving you the opportunity to walk on the bridge before returning back to the hotel.

MONDAY Boarding the coach after breakfast we make our way to RAF Museum Cosford home to over 70 aircraft of international importance, adjacent to an active airfield with numerous exhibits, before returning home to Lincolnshire with comfort stop en-route.
